



## Abolishing Double Ad Valorem Stamp Duty on Non-residential Property transactions

As a result of the economic slowdown and uncertainties surrounding the COVID-19 outbreak, the government has abolished the Double Ad Valorem Stamp Duty (DSD) imposed on non-residential properties with effect from 26th November 2020.







## Impairment implications of COVID-19 (HKAS 36 - Impairment of Assets & HKFRS 9 - Financial Instruments)

HKAS 36 requires assets within the scope to be tested for impairment loss when there are indicators at the end of the reporting period.

COVID-19 has caused disruptions to supply chains and reductions in revenue and profitability which are indicators for impairment. Whether to recognize the effect of COVID-19, entities should determine whether the effects have occurred before the year-end.

HKFRS 9 states that impairment loss on financial assets – amortized cost should be recognized at the end of the reporting period.
